

Verily Allah is the only God. Far is it from His Holiness that He should have a son. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is in the earth. And sufficient is Allah as a Guardian. (4:172)

Allah says:

It is not in accord with the Majesty of Allah that He should take unto Himself a son. Holy is He. When he decrees a thing, He says:Be, and it is. (19:36)

QURAN TELLS US; HOW ALLAH CREATED THE UNIVERSE

AND CREATED EVERYTHING IN IT FOR OUR USE

ALLAH CREATED THE UNIVERSE

He it is who created for you all that is in the earth; then He turned towards the heavens, and He perfected them as seven heavens; and He knows all things. (2:30)

Allah is the Creator of all things and He is the Guardian of all things. (39:63)

He it is who made perfect everything He has created. (32:8)

It is He Who has created seven heavens in harmony. No incongruity can you see in the creation of the Gracious God. Then look again. Can you see any flaw? (67:4)

We created the heavens and the earth and all that is between them in six periods and we suffered no tiredness. (50:39)

And we have not created the heavens and the earth and all that is between them in vain. (38:28)

It is He who made the earth a bed for you and the heavens a roof. (2:23)

Do not the disbelievers realise that the heavens and the earth were a solid mass, then We opened them out. And we made every living thing from water. Will they not then believe? (21:31)



Everything in the universe is created by Allah. He created the Universe in six stages and He did not rest at all.

The Holy Quran tells us that the whole universe, particularly the solar system has developed out of an amorphous mass. God, in accordance with the laws which He hadset in motion, split the mass of matter and its scattered bits became the units of the solar system. God then created all life out of water.

Have you not seen how Allah created seven heavens in perfect harmony and has placed the moon therein as a light, and made the sun as a lamp? (71:16,17)

And the sun is moving on the course prescribed for it. That is the decree of the Almighty, the All-Knowing God. And for the moon We have appointed stages, till it becomes again like an old dry branch of a palm tree. It is not for the sun to overtake the moon, nor can the night outstrip the day. All of them float in an orbit. (36:39-41)



The solar system with its sun, moon, planets and stars is a well-ordered and well regulated system which has existed for millions of years, never having once suffered the slightest disorder or deviation in the movement of these bodies.

The Holy Quran tells us that the heavenly bodies float through space or ether. It contradicts the view held that sun is stationary and that the heavens were solid in their formation as was believed for a long long time. It tells us that all celestial and terrestrial bodies perform their allotted tasks regularly, punctually without trespassing on one another's sphere of action.


Allah says:

Allah is He Who raised up the heavens without any pillars that you can see. (13:3)

All praise is due to Allah Who created the heavens and the earth and brought into being every kind of darkness and light. (6:2)



The night and the day, the sun and the moon have all been created by God. All of them fulfil human needs and are indispensable for man's existence on earth.

All reckoning and all calendars depend on the movements of the sun and the moon. The moon moves round the earth and thereby we are able to know the measures of months: The earth moves round the sun and also rotates on its own axis, thus enabling us to measure our years as well as our days.

Allah says:

In the creation of the heavens and the earth and in the alteration of the night and the day there are indeed signs for men of understanding. (3:191)

He it is Who made the sun radiate a brilliant light and the moon reflect a lustre, and appointed stages for it, that you may keep count of years and for the reckoning of time. (10:6)

The sun and moon move according to a fixed reckoning. (55:6)







Quran tells us that God has created all things in pairs. Pairs exist in vegetable kingdom, and even in inorganic matter. Even the so called elements do not exist by themselves.






Call upon your Lord in humility and in solitude. Surely He does not love the transgressors. (7:56)

Glorify thy Lord with His praise before the rising of the sun and before its setting; and glorify Him in the hours of the night and all parts of the day, that thou mayest find true happiness. (20:131)

The months of the Haj are well known; so whoever determines to perform the Pilgrimage in these months should remember that there is to be no foul talk, nor any transgression, nor any quarrelling during the Pilgrimage. And whatever good you do, Allah knows it. And furnish yourselves with necessary provisions, and surely the best provision is righteousness. And fear Me alone, o men of understanding. (2:198)

IV THE HOLY QURAN TELLS US ABOUT ANGELS

ANGELS

Angels are God's agents. They bring messages of God and execute His will in the universe.

The angels possess powers and qualities in varying degrees and in accordance with the importance of the work entrusted to each one of them. The Arch-angel Gabriel is the chief of all the angels and therefore the most important work of carrying Divine revelation to God's Messengers is entrusted to him and is done under his care and supervision.

Some other angels are Michael, Israfil and Israel. Belief in angels is an article of Muslim faith.



THE DIVINIE BOOKS

Suhf-i-Ibrahim given to Hazrat Ibrahim (Abraham) peace be upon him, Taurat given to hazrat Moosa (Moses) peace upon him, Zabur given to Hazrat Dawood (David) peace be upon him, Injil given to Hazrat Isa (Jesus) peace be upon him and the Holy Quran revealed word by word to Hazrat Muhammad, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, are some of the Divine Books mentioned in the Holy Quran. A Muslim has to believe in all the Divine Books.

While all previous Books were addressed to a particular people and were sent to fulfil the specific needs of the time, the Holy Quran has been revealed for the benefit of the whole of mankind.

Therefore though from the point of view of revelation, all Divine Books are doubtless equal, yet some are superior to others on account of the quantum of their contents and the perfection of matters relating to the faith contained therein. From this point of view the Holy Quran is superior to all Books in as much as are necessary for perfecting the religion, as, for instance, questions relating to the Unity of God, the negation of all types of shirk, remedies for the spiritual ills, arguments for the rejection of false religions and the proof of true doctrines that are set out forcefully in the Holy Quran. Quran, therefore, is a perfect Book, which comprises all knowledge and wisdom and its teachings are everlasting.

SUHF WERE GIVEN TO ABRAHAM



Verily, he truly prospers who purifies himself, And remembers the name of his Lord and offers Prayers. But you prefer the life of this world, whereas the Hereafter is better and more lasting.

This indeed is what is taught in the former Scriptures-The Scriptures of Abraham and Moses. (87:15-20)

Allah says:

God said to Moses:

And remember the time when We took a covenant from you and raised high above you the Mount, saying: 'Hold fast that which We have given you and bear in mind what is therein, that you may be saved.' (2:64)

MANY JEWS PROFESSED BELIEF IN TORAH BUT DO NOT ACT ON ITS COMMANDMENTS

PEOPLE OF MOSES BROKE THE COVENANT WITH GOD AND PERVERTED THE TORAH

Allah revealed the Holy Quran to Prophet Muhammad, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him. It is a perfect Book which contains imperishable teachings, eternal truths and guidance for mankind. The Holy Quran is a Book which has proclaimed its own matchlessness and has claimed its own greatness, its wisdom, its truth, the beauty of its composition and its spiritual lights.

There is no truth outside of it. There is no wisdom that is not comprised in it. There is no light that is not obtainable through following it. We should therefore honour this holy book and lead our lives according to its teachings.

Allah says:







Those who devour interest stand like one whom Satan has smitten with insanity. That is because they say, 'Trade also is like interest'; whereas Allah has made trade lawful and made interest unlawful. It is no sin on your part to enter houses where no body lives and wherein are your goods. Allah knows what you reveal and what you conceal. (24:28-30)

These are three times of privacy for you. At times other than these there is no blame on you or on them, for they have to move about waiting upon you, some of you attending upon others. Thus does Allah make plain to you the Signs; for Allah is All-Knowing, Wise.

And when the children among you attain to puberty, they too should ask permission, even as those mentioned before them asked permission. Thus does Allah make plain to you His commandments; and Allah is All-Knowing, Wise. (24:59,60)

TAKE CARE OF ORPHANS

Allah says:

Do not approach the property of the orphan during his minority, except for the most beneficent purpose. (17:35)

Hand over their property to the orphans and do not exchange the bad for the good, and do not devour their property mixing it with your own. Surely that is a great sin. (4:3)



It is these whose reward is forgiveness from their Lord and Gardens beneath which rivers flow, wherein they shall abide. Excellent is the reward of those who work righteousness. (3:135-137)

Verily Allah commands you to make over the trust to those entitled to them. (4:59)

CONSULT PEOPLE


Consult them (people) in matters of administration (3:160)



Do not cover up evidence and whoever covers it up, his heart is certainly sinful. (2:284)

FULFIL YOUR COVENANT

Allah says:

Fulfil every covenant for you will be called to account for it. (17:35)

DO NOT DESPAIR OF ALLAH'S MERCY


VIII THE HOLY QURAN TELLS US ABOUT PROPHETS

The Prophets are raised by God to guide mankind to the right path. Their basic function is to bring people, among whom they are raised, closer to God. They face opposition but they carry out their duties steadfastly and eventually they win. Muslims believe that Messengers have been sent by God to all nations. There are some which are mentioned in the Holy Quran but there are many others which are not mentioned therein.

Belief in all Prophets of God is a fundamental article of Muslim faith. While previous prophets were sent to a particular nation, tribe or people the Holy Prophet Muhammad peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, was sent by God Almighty to the whole of mankind. On account of his qualities and excellences, Muhammad, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, was a combination of all prophets, as he combined in himself, all the diverse guidances, which other prophets had brought. The Holy Prophet Muhammad came into this world at a time when the world was demanding a great reformer and all peoples had abandoned true doctrines and were involved paganism, misguidance and creature in worship.

The life of the Holy Prophet Muhammad was a life of great success. In his high moral qualities, his spiritual power, his high resolve, the excellences and perfection of his teaching, his perfect example and the acceptance of his prayers, in short, in every aspect of his life, he exhibited such bright signs that even a person of low intellegence, provided he is not inspired by unreasonable rancour and enmity, is faced to confess that he was a perfect example of manifestation of Divine qualities and was a perfect man.

ALLAH HAS SENT MESSENGERS TO EVERY PEOPLE



Allah said to Muhammad:

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


ALLAH HELPS HIS MESSENGERS





IX

THE HOLY QURAN TELLS US ABOUT THE LIFE HEREAFTER

After belief in one God, belief in the Day of Judgement is the most emphasised doctrine mentioned in the Holy Quran. No other revealed book draws such a vivid picture of Life after Death as does the Holy Quran.

According to the Holy Quran, the entire universe will come to an end on the Day Of Judgement. The dead will be resurrected and accounts will be taken of their deeds. People with good records will entre into heaven while those with bad records will be thrown into hell. According to the teachings of Islam, hell is a temporary abode while heaven is everlasting.

The Garden promised to the righteous has rivers of water that is not corrupted; and rivers of milk of which the taste changes not; and rivers of wine full of delight for those who drink; and rivers of pure honey. Thus paradise may be understood as having endless streams flowing with these things. The water of life which a person, possessing insight, drinks spiritually in this life will be present overtly in the life to come. The spiritual milk of which he drinks spiritually like a suckling babe in this world, will be seen openly in paradise. The wine of the love of God with which he was spiritually drunk in the world will be made manifest in paradise in streams. The honey of the sweetness of the faith, which one possessed of insight, swallowed spiritually in the world will be felt and observed in the shape of streams in paradise. In short, spiritual condition will be no longer hidden but will become physically visible.

THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT THE DAY OF RESURRECTION WOULD COME

Allah is He beside Whom there is none worthy of worship. He will certainly continue to assemble you till the Day of Resurrection, about which there is no doubt. And who is more truthful in his word than Allah? (4:88)

The Hour will surely come; there is no doubt about it; yet most men believe not. (40:60)

How can you disbelieve in Allah? When you were without life, He gave you life, and then He will cause you to die, then restore you to life, and then to Him shall you be made to return. (2:29)

THOSE WHO DO NOT BELIEVE IN THE LIFE HEREAFTER WILL BE PUNISHED



The day it comes, no soul shall speak except by His permission; then some of them will prove unfortunate and others fortunate.

As for those who will prove unfortunate, they shall be in the Fire, wherein there shall be for them sighing and sobbing, Abiding therein so long as the heavens and the earth endure, excepting what thy Lord may will. Surely, thy Lord does bring about what He pleases.

But as for those who will prove fortunate, they shall be in Heaven; abiding therein so long as the heavens and the earth endure, excepting what thy Lord may will-a gift that shall not be cut off. (11:106-109)

TAQDEER OR DIVINE DECREE

TAQDEER

A Muslim believes in TAQDEER or DIVINE DECREE. According to the teachings of the Holy Quran Taqdeer or God's Decree controls the eventual outcome of all actions.

Man is subject to Divine decree. If a human design is not in accord with the design of God, no amount of effort can succeed in putting it into effect; but when the time of the design of God arrives, that which had appeared most difficult becomes easily available.

It should be remembered that though everything has been determined by Divine decree, yet this does not mean that one should not strive for one's betterment or adopt means to avoid the calamities.

Divine decrees are of two types; one may be described as suspended, and other as absolute. The operation of a suspended decree may be averted by the grace of God Almighty through prayers and almsgiving. The operation of an absolute decree cannot be averted through prayer and almsgiving, though God Almighty bestows some other benefit in return for them. In some cases God Almighty causes a delay in the operation of a decree.

ISLAM

The purpose of religion is that man should obtain deliverance from his passions and should develop personal love for God Almighty.

Such love of God is the paradise which will appear in diverse shapes in the Hereafter. To be unaware of the true God and to keep away from Him and not to have any love for Him is the Hell which will appear in diverse shapes in the Hereafter. Thus the true purpose of religion is to have full faith in Allah.

Islam is such a religion. It presents a living God while all other religions believe in God which according to them is not living any more. It is such a blessed, and God indicating religion that if a person follows it truly and acts upon the teachings, guidance and admonition that are contained in the Holy Word of God Almighty, the Holy Quran, he would see God in this very life. For the recognition of God who is hidden from the sight of the world behind a thousand screens, there is no other means except the teaching of the Quran. The Holy Quran guides towards God Almighty through reason and heavenly Signs in a very easy manner. It comprehends a blessing and a magnetic power which draws a seeker of God, every moment towards God and bestows light and comfort and satisfaction.

Islam is a religion which is comprehensive, perfect, complete and free from every defect in its doctrine, teachings and commandments.

A person can be held to be a Muslim when the whole of his being together with all his faculties, physical and spiritual, is devoted to God Almighty, and the trusts that are committed to him by God Almighty are rendered back to the True Giver. He should demonstrate his being a Muslim not only doctrinally but also in practice. In other words, a person claiming to be a Muslim should prove that his hands, feet, heart, mind, his reason, understanding, anger, compassion, meekness, knowledge, all his physical and spiritual faculties, his honour, property, comfort, delight and whatever pertains to him from the top of his head to the soles of his feet, together with his motives, fears and passions have all been subordinated to Almighty God as a person's limbs are subordinated to him.
