On February 28, 2014, Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper) delivered the Friday Sermon at the Baitul Futūh Mosque, Morden, London.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: In my last sermon, I had discussed how profoundly God had blessed Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ with secular and spiritual knowledge. As a matter of fact it may take one year to fully expound the great accomplishments of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Today, I would like to speak about the Wembley Conference held in London in 1924. It was attended by Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ along with the 12 members of his delegation. I would also quote the impressions of certain English dignitaries who attended the conference and admired the extraordinary scholarship of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: It was under special guidance and help of the Almighty that Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ decided to take part in the conference. It was a first ever visit of a Khalīfatul Masīh to Europe. On his way to London, Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ also stopped in Syria, Egypt and Palestine. Hence, there are some historical aspects of this visit of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ which should be known to the Ahmadī youth.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ penned a treatise in Urdu, which was translated into English by Hazrat Chaudhry Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Sahib in collaboration with Hazrat Maulvi Sher Ali Sahib and Hazrat Sahibzada Mirzā Bashir Ahmad Sahib رضی اللہ عنہ and was then read in the conference by Hazrat Chaudhry Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Sahib. The conference began on 23 September 1924. Before Hazrat Chaudhry Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Sahib stood up to read the treatise, Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ came up to the rostrum and spoke briefly about himself and the Jamā'at and thanked the organisers for holding such a commendable event. Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ then invited Hazrat Chaudhry Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Sahib to come to the stage and read the treatise. Hazrat Chaudhry Muhammad Zafrullah Khan Sahib read it in such a remarkable manner that the true and magnificent image of Islām and Ahmadiyyat was satisfactorily conveyed to the people. This fulfilled a vision seen by the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام about the propagation of Islām and Ahmadiyyat in London.

The audience listened to the address in a trance and with rapt attention. In the treatise, Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ shed light on how the Ahmadiyyat Jamā'at was formed, what the claim of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام was regarding his status as the Messiah and Mahdī and how the institution of Khalīfat succeeded the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام under Divine guidance. In addition, Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضی اللہ عنہ also wrote about how the Ahmadiyya Jamā'at was rapidly spreading across the globe and how people from other faiths were joining Ahmadiyyat in large numbers, and how God speaks to

His righteous servants and grants their prayers. Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه said that by sending the Promised Messiah عليه السلام into the world God has granted the world the means to reform itself.

Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) said: Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه also discussed in his treatise the status of the prophets of God Almighty and highlighted the importance of establishing a true relationship of man with God inasmuch as it is imperative if one wants to excel in spirituality. He also said that the Holy Qur'ān categorically rejects the allegation that Islām was spread by sword. Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه touched in his treatise on a number of other issues as well, such as authentic Islāmīc point of view regarding slavery, interest, polygamy, and divorce, as well as moral teachings of Islām and life after death. Moreover, he proved the truth of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام by elaborating on the signs God Almighty showed in his support. The treatise ended with the following words: 'Dear sisters and brothers! The light of the Almighty has shown forth for you. The glory of the Almighty God has been made manifest for you through a prophet. Therefore, do thou accept this light and let your hearts be lit up by it'.

Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) said: Thus did Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه elaborate with great wisdom and courage on the excellent qualities of Islām and invited the people to Islām.

Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) also quoted the views and impressions of some worthy participants of the conference regarding the treatise of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه and said that the treatise was well-received and praised by all the learned participants of the conference.

Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) said: The treatise was read in English and is easily available, so our English-speaking members and youth should read it. May Allāh shower countless blessings upon the soul of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه who left a great intellectual heritage for us on almost every subject. *Fadl-e-Umar* Foundation should also speed up work now on the translations of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ūd رضي الله عنه's books in various languages.

Further, Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) spoke of Kamal Ahmad Krogh Sahib of Denmark who passed away on February 19, 2014. Huzoor (May Allāh be is Helper) praised Mr Kamal Ahmad Krogh Sahib's services for the Jamā'at and mentioned the noble qualities found in him and announced that he would lead Krogh Sahib's funeral prayer in absentia after the Juma Prayer.
