Jamā‘at Ahmadiyya,

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Dear Brother,

السلام علیکم ورحمة اللہ وبرکاتہ

On 28 March 2014, Hadrat Khalifatul Masih V (May Allāh be his Helper) delivered the Friday Sermon at the Baitul Futūh Mosque, Morden, London.

Quoting extracts from the writings of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام and relating incidents from his blessed life, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) continued with the subject of Divine signs shown for the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) quoted the Promised Messiah عليه السلام: The signs God showed in my support are in excess of three hundred thousand .... Some of these signs are to do with occasions when God Almighty, in keeping with His promise, protected me from being harmed by the enemy. Some of the signs are such that, in keeping with His promise, God always fulfilled my needs and my wishes. And some are of the kind whereby, in keeping with His promise ‘I shall humiliate him who designs to humiliate thee’, God brought humiliation and disgrace upon those who tried to harm me. Some signs are of the kind in which, according to His prophecies, He made me victorious over those who filed lawsuits against me. Some pertain to the length of my ministry; for ever since the world was created, no impostor has ever been allowed such a long period of respite. Some signs are of the kind as are manifested through observing the condition of the age, i.e., this age is in need of an Imam. Some signs represent the fulfilment of my prayers in favour of my friends. Some represent the fulfilment of my prayer against malicious enemies. Some signs are of the kind in which terminally ill patients were cured and I was informed of their recovery in advance. Some signs are of the nature whereby, for my sake, God caused a number of heavenly and earthly calamities as a testimony for the truthfulness of my claim. Some are of the sort whereby many eminent and renowned saints saw dreams in which the Holy Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم appeared to them and testified to my claim...Some signs are such that thousands of people pledged *Bai‘at* at my hand only because they were informed in a dream of my truthfulness and of my being from God; while some others did so because they saw the Holy Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم in a dream, and he told them that the end of the world was near and that I was the last Vicegerent of God and the Promised

Messiah عليه السلام. Some signs relate to certain eminent saints who mentioned me by name even before my birth, or before I came of age, and spoke about my being the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) further quoted the Promised Messiah عليه السلام: I say to you truthfully not to be impertinent towards the signs of God Almighty and not to look down on them. For this indicates your deprivation. And, God does not approve of this...I say it again that it is not good to deny the signs of God, for it makes one worthy of Divine wrath.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) quoted incidents from the life of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام whereby people suffering from various ailments were healed as a sign of God.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also read extracts from the writings of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام wherein he described how God caused the ruin of his enemies. Also, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) explained how God caused plague to spread in the sub-continent and kill some of the worst enemies of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) quoted the Promised Messiah عليه السلام who said: I have been sent to re-establish the glory of the Holy Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم in the world and to demonstrate to people the truthfulness of the Holy Qur'ān. And, this is already happening. However, those whose hearts are not blessed with insight, fail to see it happening.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) further quoted the Promised Messiah عليه السلام: God appointed me to bring about reformation. He showed such signs in my person that if people who are free of prejudice and have fear of God in their hearts and think judiciously, are informed about them, they can understand the reality of Islam very well from these signs...Some of my prophecies pertained to the vital matters of the unseen and the noteworthy occurrences indicating the advent of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام. Among these signs were the lunar and solar eclipses in the month of Ramadān and the spreading of the plague in this country. All these testimonies have been fulfilled for me and up till now I have also seen a quarter of the fourteenth century. The proofs and evidences are so large in number that if they were all written down, they could not be contained even in a thousand volumes.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) related some incidents of how some people have recently accepted Ahmadiyat and how God, during the lifetime of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام, guided people to him through dreams. Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) quoted the Promised Messiah عليه السلام: Such guidance from God will continue to be given to the Jamā‘at until it has reached its pinnacle.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: This prophecy made by the Promised Messiah عليه السلام is being fulfilled today in a glorious manner. People living thousands of miles away have testified that God guided them to the Promised Messiah عليه السلام through dreams. Many of these people belonged to Africa, and many to other continents. They have all testified that God showed them dreams wherein He guided them to the truthfulness of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام. This constitutes a great sign of the Almighty God in support of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

The Promised Messiah عليه السلام said: As these were to be the latter days and Satan’s onslaught, along with his spawns, was to be the last, God Almighty therefore merged thousands of signs in one place to defeat Satan. Yet, those among people who have satanic nature do not accept and present undue allegations merely as calumny. They want this movement which was started by God to perish. However, God wishes to strengthen it with His own hands until it reaches the stage of excellence.

Towards the end of the Friday Sermon, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) asked the Jamā‘at to remember the Muslim Ummah and the Ahmadīs living in various countries in their prayers.
