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# سُورَةُ الْفِيلِ

## Surah Al-Fiel

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ ﴿١﴾

الَّذِي تَرَى كَيْفَ فَعَلَ رَبُّكَ بِأَصْحَابِ الْفِيلِ ﴿٢﴾

الَّذِي جَعَلَ كَيْدَهُمْ فِي تَضْلِيلٍ ﴿٣﴾ وَأَرْسَلَ

عَلَيْهِمْ طَيْرًا أَبَابِيلَ ﴿٤﴾ تَرْمِيهِمْ بِحِجَارَةٍ

مِّنْ سِجِّيلٍ ﴿٥﴾ فَجَعَلَهُمْ كَعَصْفٍ مَّا كُوِيَ ﴿٦﴾

## Meem Saakinah

The letter Meem with sukoon or Jazm is called Meem Sakinah

### *Special rules concerning Meem Sakinah*

**These can be classified into three sets:**

- 1) Reading Meem Sakinah with **strong** nasal sound (Ghunnah)
- 2) Reading Meem Sakinah with **light** nasal sound (Ghunnah)
- 3) Reading Meem Sakinah **without** nasal sound (Ghunnah)

## Strong Nasal Sound

- Meem Saakinah will be pronounced with **strong** nasal sound (ghunnah) if it is followed by the letter **Meem**.

إِلَيْكُمْ مُرْسَلُونَ - عَلَيْهِم مِّنْ صِدَّةٍ

In Arabic terminology it is called : IDGHAAM SHAFAWI

## Light Nasal Sound

- Meem Saakinah will be pronounced with **light** nasal sound (ghunnah) if it is followed by the letter **Baa**.

يَعْتَصِمُ بِاللَّهِ - رُسُلُهُمْ بِالْبَيِّنَاتِ

In Arabic terminology it is called : IKHFA SHAFAWI

## No Nasal Sound

- Meem Saakinah will **not** be pronounced with nasal sound (ghunnah) if it is followed by **any other letter** than Baa or Meem

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ - أَنْعَمْتَ - أَمْرًا لَمْ

In Arabic terminology it is called : IZHAAR SHAFAWI

## Practice of Rules of Meem Saakinah

تَنْزِيلُ الْمَلَايِكَةِ وَالرُّوحِ فِيهَا بِإِذْنِ رَبِّهِمْ<sup>ع</sup> مِنْ كُلِّ أَمْرِ

إِنَّ رَبَّهُمْ بِهِمْ يَوْمَئِذٍ لَخَبِيرٌ

وَأَمْنَهُمْ مِنْ خَوْفٍ
